

AMA Supercross Visits the Georgia Dome on Two Back-to-Back Weekends

The Monster Energy Supercross will visit the Georgia Dome on back to back weekends in February. The first event will be on 21 February and the second event will the next weekend, 28 February. Atlanta and Anaheim, California are the only two venues with multiple races.

The Atlanta races have attracted some of the largest capacity crowds in each of the last few years. The Georgia Dome will host the eighth and ninth races of the seventeen race 2015 schedule. The season's first event was at Angel Stadium in Anaheim and the season will wrap up at Sam Boyd Stadium in Las Vegas in May. Fourteen cities are on the tour, crisscrossing the USA from California to Phoenix to Texas to Georgia to Daytona Beach. Then in March the tour swings north to Indianapolis and, Detroit the slightly south to St Louis then to Houston. The last three race start in Santa Clara, CA, then to New Jersey and

After the Oakland race, Cooper Webb maintains the points lead of the 250SX Class and Ryan Dungey in the 450SX Class.
