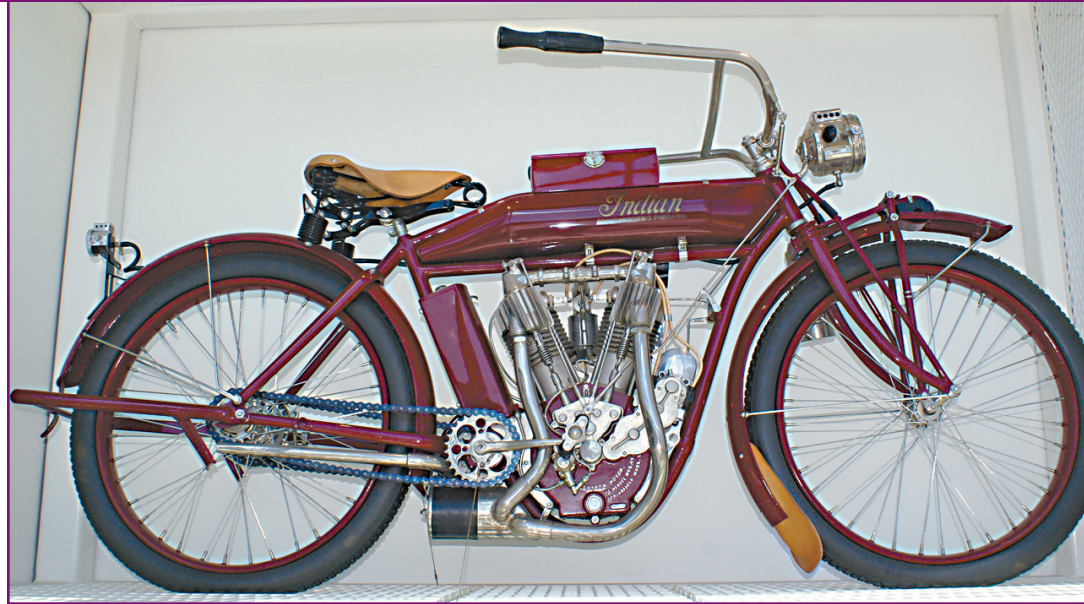

At the time, Indian was the largest producer of motorcycles in the world, building over 20,000 machines in 1913, and by 1923 they had reached the milestone of a quarter of a million machines.
