This custom motorcycle was built by Atlanta's Hank Young, and was featured on the Discovery Channel's "Biker Build Off."

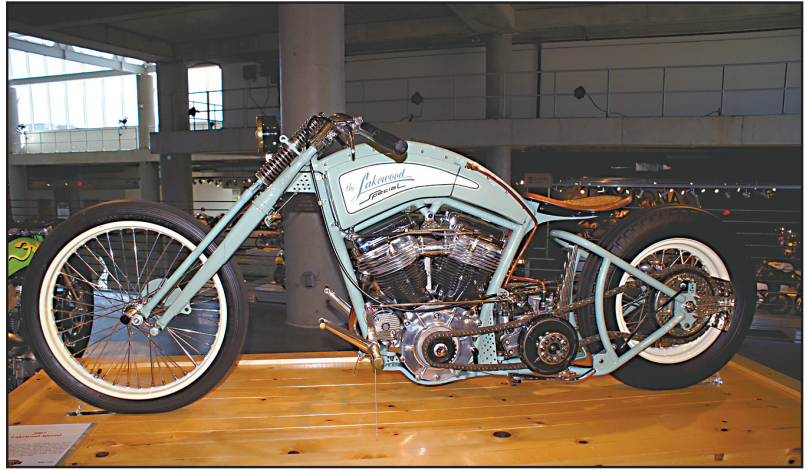

Nothing mass produced, just a use of old parts skillfully crafted to produce a very unique machine. Simply calling this bike a special construction doesn't even come close.
