Casey Roderick 2017 Driver of the Year. With 18 victories, 27 top-five and 32 top-10 finishes so far on the short tracks of the Southeast, Casey Roderick of Lawrenceville was the unanimous choice of a media panel to be the Georgia Racing Hall of Fame's Driver of the Year.

Roderick, who drives primarily for Georgia Racing Hall of Famer Ronnie Sanders and is considered one of the top young drivers in America, also has three championships already this season.


