Daniel Hemric holds off Chase Elliott to win Southern Super Series at Cordele

In the inaugural Southern Super Series visit to Crisp Motorsports Park (Watermelon Capital Speedway) and the only 2015 visit to Georgia, Daniel Hemric battled Chase Elliott to take the checkered flag. The win was Hemric's second SSS victory of the season in the Lyles Farms 100 presented by PFC Brakes.

The 3/8 mile D-shaped oval that is the Watermelon Capital Speedway at Crisp Motorsports Park is a multi-grooved asphalt track allowing drivers to maneuver from the bottom to the top. Hemric, Elliott and 14 year-old Harrison Burton, son of Jeff Burton used all of the grooves in their side-by-side battles throughout the 100 laps.

On lap 52, Dominique Van Wieringen and Logan Boyett got together in turn two. Hemric chose the outside on the restart with Burton on the inside. Burton spun the tires allowing Elliott to take second. Elliott was on Hemric's rear bumper for the next few laps. Burton powered back and on lap 65, he passed Elliott for second. Burton and Hemric battled for the lead for the next five laps, but Hemric prevailed taking over the top spot.

Burton started to fall back and Elliott regained second with Casey Roderick in third. For the last 25 laps, it was the Hemric and Elliott show with both drivers working all of the grooves. Elliott would be able to pass Hemric in Turns one and two but Hemric would fight back and take the lead in turns three and four.

With two laps to go, it appeared that

Elliott had a chance to tap Hemric in the corner but Hemric powered his way down the back stretch. With this momentum, Hemric took the checkered flag.
