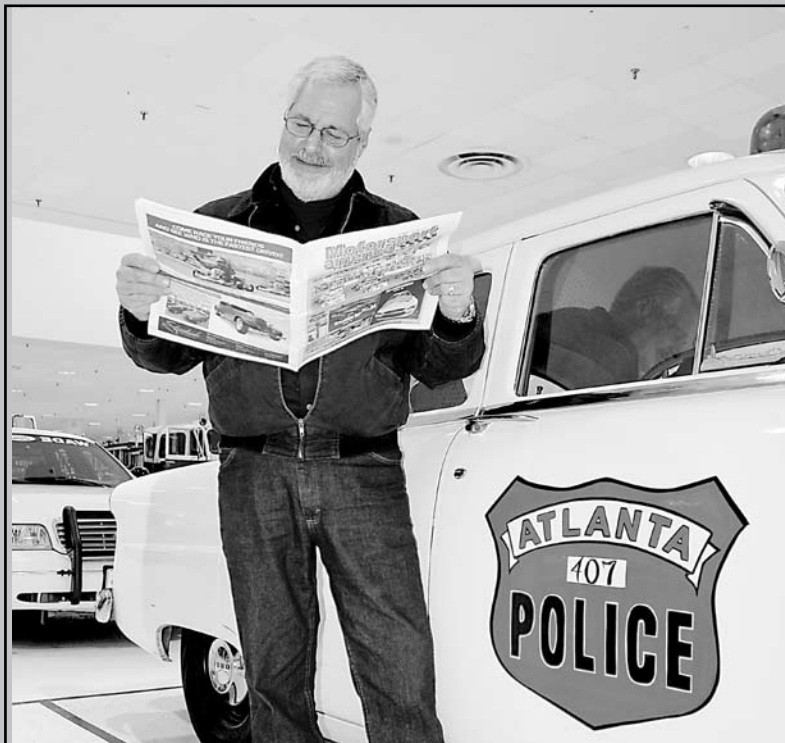

**VINTAGE BIKE: 1998 Jawa Ice Racer**



Engine: Air-cooled, single cylinder, four stroke  
 Ignition: Pal magneto  
 Power Rating: Approx. 70 bhp using methanol fuel  
 Valves: Single over-head cam, four valve head  
 Fuel System: Dell'Orto 34mm fuel carburetor  
 Transmission: Two speed  
 Brakes: None  
 Wheels: 23" front with 100 hardened steel spikes, 21" rear with 150 spikes

Ice racing is a very popular spectator sport in Northern Europe. This Jawa is specifically constructed for this type of racing, using speedway components. The unusual shape of the left handlebar allows incredible lean angles, with the rider's elbows scraping the ice. Two speed versions of these machines are known as "long track" models.
