

## Brandon Overton Wins the MODOC 100 Crate Late Model Race

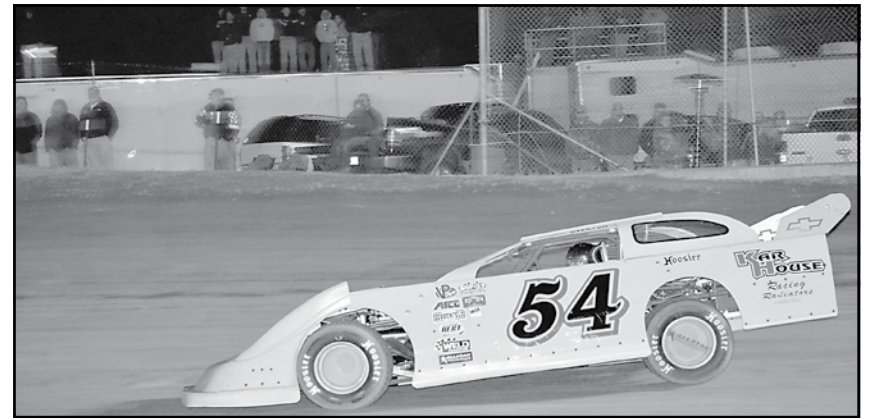

The Modoc 100 started with a challenge in track prep. Rains earlier on Thursday and Friday left the track surface with a thick layer of mud but track promoter, Lenny Hobbs, was determined the race



would happen. He brought in bulldozers and motor grader from a contractor plus the track equipment and pushed the surface mud to the inside and made a raceable surface that hosted 45 Crate Late Models + 5 support classes. Over 100 cars were entered in the event.

Daniel Roland (16) won the Super Street class, Greg Parks (82) won the Stock V8 class, Brian Rice (5) won the Road Warrior Class, RJ Thomas (55) won the Super

Stock Class, and Chris Meadows (34) won the Extreme 4 Class.
