One crew member was treated at the infield care center and another crew member was transported to a local hospital. There were 6 cautions for 31 laps and 23 lead changes among 11 leaders.

Brothers Dillon started on the front row of the XFINITY race. Austin won the Coors Light pole for the Winn-Dixie 300 at Tal-

ladesga Superspeedway with a speed of 180.540mph, Ty Dillon started second. After the race, Ty emerged with the XFINITY points lead.
