The winner's average speed was 108.809 mph. There were 2 cautions for a total 7 laps. The lead changed 8 times by 5 different drivers. The announcers referred to track as the Alabama Rollercoaster.

In the Verizon IndyCar Series point standings: Dale Coyne Racing's Sébastien Bourdais, in the No. 18 Sonny's BBQ Honda, finished eighth in the race to retain the championship lead. Bourdais has accumulated 117 points, with Dixon second at 111, Newgarden third with 110, Pagnaud fourth with 106 and James Hinchcliff fifth at 102.

The Andretti Autosport Team had its Formula 1 driver Fernando Alonso watching the race. Alonso signed with Andretti to drive in the Indianapolis 500. The double Formula 1 world champion saw two of his team-mates in the top 10 with Rossi's fifth and Takuma Sato in ninth.

Barber officials announced a three-day
