It is finally a reality. The tunnel to the infield which will allow two-way traffic of haulers and large motor homes 24 hours a day is finished with the final layer of asphalt and the sod being laid at this time.

The top layer of asphalt is mixed with a polymer in it to make is very hard and to resist cracking in the summer heat and the winters cold.

A ribbon cutting ceremony was performed after a press conference that was attended by NASCAR driver Jeffery Earnhardt. He is a part time driver for Joe Gibbs Racing in the No. 18 iK9. He's had a good season with leading 29 laps in the NXS season opener at Daytona followed by a sixth place finish at Atlanta. He will

compete at Texas, the Money Lion 300 at Talladega and make his MENCS 2019 debut in the No. 81 for X-treme Concepts Racing in the GEICO 500.

After the press conference the Media staff was shuttled to the infield side of the tunnel to see the famous Johnny Rays Big Rig come through the tunnel. It is the truck that carries the huge American flag around Talladega during the National Anthem, a huge crowd pleaser. AS the huge truck comes to a halt out comes Jeffery Earnhardt. He becomes the first NASCAR driver through the tunnel.

The Media was then shuttled to the new premium RV infield Finish Line sites which all have full hookups. This eliminates the generator noise and the problem of conserving water and full gray water
