NHRA Arizona Nationals at Wild Horse Pass Motorsports Park

In the second event of the 2018 NHRA Mello Yello Drag Racing Series, Courtney Force took home the Funny Car victory at the 34th annual NHRA Arizona Nationals at Wild Horse Pass Motorsports Park in front of a sellout crowd.

Force emerged victorious with a run of 3.834 seconds at 337.16 mph in her Advance Auto Parts Chevy Camaro took down Tommy Johnson Jr. in the final round. After earning the No. 1 qualifier on Saturday, Force secured her first victory since Houston 2016.

Torrence powered his Capco Contractors/Torrence Racing dragster to the Top Fuel victory with a run of 3.729 at 330.72 to take down Scott Palmer in the final round. After locking down a career-best eight victories in 2017, Torrence recorded a victory in Phoenix for the first

time in his career.

In Pro Stock, McGaha drove to the winner's circle with a 6.529 at 211.59 run in his Harlow Sammons Chevrolet Camaro to defeat Jason Line in the final round. He secured his sixth career victory and first since winning the Four-Wide Nationals last season in Charlotte.

In a scary incident, John Force, who qualified fourth, was racing alongside Jonnie Lindberg in the second round of eliminations when he experienced a spectacular explosion at the finish line on his way to a 4.13-second victory. The concussion sent Force's car — with its demolished Camaro body — across the centerline in the shutdown area, where it made contact with Lindberg's Toyota, ultimately sending both cars careening into the guardrail.

Lindberg climbed from his battered machine under his own power, while Force, confirmed to be alert and speaking to Safety Safari personnel, was transported to an area hospital due to the severity of the accident. Force later returned to Wild Horse Pass to celebrate daughter Courtney's Funny Car victory.

After his explosion and crash, John Force discussed

the incident and the emotional weekend John Force Racing had at the NHRA Arizona Nationals. How are you feeling? "I feel great. I was in the office at 7 a.m. Tuesday morning. Thanks to Simpson. The helmet protected me. I have no complaints. The race car protected me. We build good race cars and we can always try and build them better. John Force is good, I am healthy. I am going to get a couple of check-ups to make sure I am okay. I was already goofy."
