1. If a fan arrives in a vehicle that has a handicapped





license plate OR a handicapped hanger

2. If he/she does not have either of the above, but are visibly handicapped -

HE/SHE NEEDS TO PURCHASE A PARKING PASS (whatever the event rate is) AND WE WILL STICKER THE PASS WITH A HANDICAP STICKER.

HE/SHE WILL THEN HAVE FULL ACCESS TO THE SUPPORT AND MAIN PADDOCK
